In accordance with ITT Clause 7.1 (Clarification of Tendering Document) of the Open National Tender (ONT) issued under the above reference, we hereby respond to query raised by one prospective bidder:

Question 1

Registration Requirements:

- ITT 16.4 states, "Goods to be supplied under the Contract shall be registered with the Pharmacy & Poisons Board (PPB) in Kenya."
- We request clarification on whether registration with the PPB is the *sole* acceptable registration. Specifically, we note that certain items included in the kits, such as chlorine tablets, and sanitizers, are typically registered with the Kenya Bureau of Standards (KEBS).
- Request:** Please confirm whether registration with KEBS for applicable items will be accepted in lieu of, or in addition to, PPB registration.

Response

The Medicines included in the CHP Kit require PPB Certificate. Chlorine water tablets require KEBS certificates.

Question 2

Technical Evaluation Documentation:

- B. Technical Evaluation (i) - Pharmaceutical Products, Point (d):** This section requires valid registration or retention certificate with QR Code issued by the Kenya Pharmacy and Poisons Board (PPB).
- Request:** Similar to point 1, please clarify whether KEBS registration is acceptable for items that fall under KEBS jurisdiction.
- B. Technical Evaluation (ii) - Non-Pharmaceutical/Laboratory Products, Point (b):** This section requires a "current and valid manufacturing Certificate of Quality by an independent recognized body to the manufacturer of the product. The certificate must be item specific."
- Request:** Please provide clarification regarding the requirement for this certificate for non-medical items included in the kits, such as the backpack bag, jacket, CHP badge holder with lanyard, flags, water bottle, medicine box, reusable waste bag, pocket sharp container, and first aid box. As these items do not typically require such certificates?

Response

For non-medical items included in the Kit Such as Backpack Bag, Reflector Jacket, CHP Badge Holder with Lanyard, Flags, Water Bottle, Medicine Box, Reusable Waste Bag. Do not require PPB Certificate.

Pocket Sharps Container Requires PPB Certificate

First Aid Box requires KEBS Certification

Question 3

- **Backpack:** The document states " (red color with Republic of Kenya Logo, County Logo and Community Health Service logo)."
 - **Request:** Please provide the official, high-resolution logos for the Republic of Kenya, the Community Health Service, and a sample of the Counties Logo.
- **Flags for Launch:** The document states "Flags for launch."
 - **Request:** Please confirm whether a logo is required on the flags and, if so, please provide the official logo.

- **Request:** Please provide a detailed breakdown of the 7,831 kits by county. This information is crucial for accurate branding and logo placement, as county-specific logos will be required.

Question 5


Quantity of Medicines Discrepancy:

- There is a discrepancy in the quantity of Medicines listed on page 81 and page 88.
- Page 81 states the units per kit for Medicines is 10.
- Page 88 states the units of measure as 10x10, with units per pack as 10.
- **Request:** Please clarify the correct quantity of Medicines required and correct the discrepancy between the two pages.

Response

Unit of Measure for Zinc Sulphate 20MG and Paracetamol 500MG Tablets is a blister pack of 10's. Each CHP Kit Should have 10 Blister Packs
