CLARIFICATION 2

RE: TENDER NO KEMSA/GOK-MOH/OIT08/2023-2024 -SUPPLY OF NUTRITIONAL COMMODITIES I

The following queries were raised by interested bidders and hereby respond as follows;

Item No. 2 Super cereal Plus

With reference to the subjected tender, we are having below-mentioned queries;

Query 1:

Page 74 2 PM14SUP093 Super cereal Plus (CSB++) Bag [1]1.5Kg Bag
2,405 Packed in bag of 1.5kg (as per description that would mean $2405 \times 1.5 = 3607.5\text{kg}$), is this correct ?

Response

No.

The 1.5kg bag should be in a secondary package carton containing 10 primary bags.
Therefore, 2,405 is the number of secondary packs (cartons). Hence the right calculation is $1.5 \times 10 \times 2405 = 36,075\text{kg}$.

Query 2:

The product description on page 74 is super cereal plus (CSB++) however the technical specification describes super cereal (CSB+).

clarify which product is being requested (CSB+ or CSB++)

Response

The product requested for is super cereal (CSB+).

Item No. 4 F-75 Therapeutic milk CAN 400G/CAR-24


Query

We are seeking clarification in regards to labelling of scoop for F-75 milk,
F-75 milk specifications states on Page 94 that the scoop should be blue in colour and marked product name F-100 in addition to the Manufacturer's name.

Kindly clarify if it is correct to label the scoop for F-75 milk with the name of F-100.

Response

This is an error. The scoop of F-75 should be white in colour and labeled "F-75" while the scoop for F-100 should be blue in colour and labeled "F-100"
