Question: I am interested in bidding for the above tender. Kindly clarify if the manual SarsCov 2 RT-PCR detection kits Pack has to be a pack of 96 reactions or 48 is also acceptable.

Answer: The kits shall be packed in maximum packs of 100 tests thus any kit packed with a number of tests not exceeding 100 tests is acceptable.

- 1. The initial quantity that will be contracted is 100,000 tests.
- 2. The balance 200,000 tests is estimated quantity to be called off later.
- 3. Two suppliers will be contracted. The Purchaser will rotate the award of Call-off Contracts between the lowest and second lowest suppliers based on a balanced division of supply linked to an upper limit. The upper limit is: 75,000 tests. For the initial quantity, the lowest supplier will be awarded the upper limit of 75,000 tests and the second lowest will be awarded the balance 25,000 tests

For the first Call-off Contract, the second lowest supplier will be awarded a quantity of 50,000 to make the upper limit of 75,000 tests. From the balance quantity, the lowest bidder will be awarded to the upper limit of 75,000 tests. Any remaining quantities will again be awarded to the second lowest bidder to the upper limit.
