ADDENDUM 1:

Pursuant to ITT Clause 8, At any time prior to the deadline for submission of Tenders, the Procuring Entity may amend the tendering document by issuing addenda. Any addendum issued shall be part of the tendering document and shall be communicated in writing to all who have obtained the tendering document from the Procuring Entity in accordance with ITT 6.

In view of the above, we hereby amend the preliminary evaluation criteria nos. 1 and 5 as follows;

1. Tender documents must be paginated/serialized. All bidders are required to submit their documents paginated in a continuous ascending order from the first page to the last in this format; (i.e. 1, 2, 3..... n where n is the last page). The numbering **MUST** be sequential. All pages whether blank, back to back including dividers, bid security and price schedules **MUST** be paginated/serialized with **indelible ink**.
5. All tenders must be accompanied by an Original Bid Security valid for 150 days from date of tender opening. Value of Bid Security should be **USD 25,730.00 or KES 3,550,740.00 (Kenya Shillings Three Million, Five Hundred and Fifty Thousand, Seven Hundred and Forty Only)** or equivalent in a freely convertible currency.

Electronic tender securities are acceptable and shall be authenticated through the use of the QR scanner (*In Accordance to PPRA CIRCULAR NO. 01/2023*) **(MANDATORY)**.

A handwritten signature in blue ink, appearing to be 'A. J. M.', is written over the text.

Note: Further, tenderers attention is drawn to Instructions to Tenderers:

D. Submission and Opening of Tenders

21. Sealing and Marking of Tenders

21.1 The Tenderer shall deliver the Tender in a **single, sealed envelope** (one-envelope Tendering process). Within the single envelope the Tenderer shall place the following separate, sealed envelopes:

- a) In an envelope marked "ORIGINAL", **all** documents comprising the Tender, as described in ITB 11; and
- b) in an envelope marked "COPIES", **all** required copies of the Tender;

In view of the above, the bid security and all other bid documents **MUST** be paginated/serialized with indelible ink and placed in a single sealed envelope marked original. Also submit a copy of the original.

All other terms and conditions of the tendering document remain.
